## Our Commitment to More Sustainable Tourism

At Atlantic Holiday, we believe that holidays can and should be a force for good. From our location in Costa Adeje, we work every day to offer memorable guest experiences while also caring for the unique environment of the Canary Islands and the people who live and work here.

This Sustainability Report is updated every year and summarizes what we are doing, what we have achieved, and where we want to go in environmental matters, local community engagement, and human rights.

## What we achieved in 2025

In 2025, we took an important step in our energy transition with the installation of a solar panel structure in the hotel car park. Thanks to the efficiency measures already in place, our total energy consumption is expected to be reduced by 80%.

We achieved a 15% reduction in single-use plastics, reduced total water consumption by 8%, reduced water consumption per guest by 21%, and sourced 80% of fresh products from local suppliers within the Canary Islands.

## People and human rights

In 2025, 100% of our permanent staff completed training in Child Protection (The Code) and in Diversity and Inclusion. Our goal is for every guest, employee, and collaborator to feel safe, respected, and well treated.

Each advance is part of a clear vision: a more efficient, more responsible hotel, more connected to its environment.



### Objectives for 2026-2027

Our roadmap includes reducing energy consumption by 80% by the end of 2026, completing 100% LED lighting, measuring our CO2 footprint, installing low-flow aerators, and reducing single-use plastics by at least 10% each year until they are eliminated in 2028.

We also plan to collaborate with a local NGO on beach clean-up activities and continue increasing purchases from local and seasonal suppliers.

We designed a stay where guest comfort and environmental care go hand in hand.
